If you are double majoring, you must identify a primary and a secondary major. This means:

- Your official advisor, as far as the registrar's office is concerned, is the primary major advisor. If you choose Religious Studies as your second major, you certainly may still faculty in Religious Studies for advice.
- It is permissible to double count courses as satisfying both the foundations curriculum requirements and the second major.
- If any courses are required by both majors, they may be double counted toward both majors.
- If the primary major is a BS degree, there is no foreign language requirement for the second major.
- In a double major, no minor is required for either major.
- To initiate the Senior Summary process, you first contact your official advisor, the one for your primary major.
- Your transcript will give your degree (BA or BS) and indicate the discipline of your primary major, followed by the discipline of your second major. Your Religious Studies major will be listed this way on your transcript: "Multidisciplinary Studies: Religious Studies." Your diploma will list only the primary major. The transcript is usually the document that will be required for job applications and other career purposes.

Note: To complete a "dual degree," and receive two diplomas, you must fulfill all requirements for both majors. For more information about this option, see your advisor.
